Summer Camp at Caswell

Our youth will go back to Camp Caswell this summer for a week of Bible study, missions, and fellowship at the beach! We will travel again with the Youth from South Erwin Baptist Church, and will be at Caswell **June 17 – 22**. Sign up quickly! The guaranteed spots (3 guys and 3 girls) are almost gone. Sign-up by **February 17** for the best chance at additional slots.

To be **eligible for Camp**, Youth must **participate in Caswell fundraisers** and earn a minimum number of **6 “points” each month** (from the time they sign up for camp until we leave in June). Points are earned by participation in Youth on Wednesday night; Worship on Sunday morning; youth fellowships and mission projects; and through Bible study games, quizzes, and challenges. 12 points will earn a Youth t-shirt. Highest point totals each month will earn extra prizes!

The youth will host a pancake supper on March 9, to raise funds for our deposit to Camp Caswell (due April 1). Our goal is \$500 dollars, which will cover our expenses and the deposit. We will tithe 10% of the proceeds to our Keep the Change offering.

Youth will sell tickets (beginning February 10), set up the fellowship hall, and (with adult supervision) cook, serve, and cleanup after the meal. Great fellowship and fun!
